Due to the high number of calls the security company are now asking for a fee of \$15.00 per request. WHL are now receiving regular statements which provide a detailed list of dates, times and unit number each time access is requested. WHL will be forwarding this cost onto tenants and placing the charge against the tenants account. A letter will be sent out to those tenants affected. Please be mindful that these charges may place rent accounts into arrears and that this will need to be addressed. NEW PROPERTY DEVELOPMENT

Pumpkin Soup

Ingredients:

1 butternut pumpkin 3-4 cloves of garlic Olive Oil 1 litre of chicken stock Cream or natural yoghurt Parsley



Method:

Heat oven to 190 degrees

Cut pumpkin in half and scoop out the seeds. Place the pumpkin halves on the tray and place the unpeeled cloves of garlic into the holes where the seeds had been. Drizzle oil over the pumpkins and bake for 50-60 mins until soft and caramelised. Let cool.

Place the pumpkin flesh into a large pot removing the skin. Add the flesh of the garlic and the chicken stock and puree until smooth. Heat gently until warm. Stir in some cream or natural yoghurt and season with parsley. Yum!!

Shopping Trolleys

Shopping trolleys are continuing to be left at the front of the property near the side ramp after tenants have completed their shopping.
