



Allocation of Housing

With over 20 years' experience in the provision of secure and affordable housing for women on low to moderate income households, Women's Housing Ltd provides a diverse range of housing programs.

Women's Housing Ltd's portfolio includes General Community Housing, Transitional Housing and the Rooming House Program.

Transitional Housing

Women's Housing Limited provides transitional housing services to women and women with children who are homeless or at risk of homelessness

The Transitional Housing Management (THM) program is provided in accordance with the Office of Housing Homelessness Assistance Program Guidelines. The purpose of the WHL THM program is to assist women in crisis to make the transition to longer term, secure and sustainable housing. This program provides short to medium term accommodation (usually between 3 months to 12 months) together with individual support provided by partnering support agencies.

The Housing Services team manages 100 THM tenancies. Properties are furnished and tenancies are managed in line with the Residential Tenancies Act.

Vacancies are advertised on the DHHS Resource Register. To access vacancies you will need to contact your closest Access Point to be placed on support and transitional housing waiting lists or contact WHL on 9412 6868 for further information.

Women's Housing Ltd only houses single women and women with children in the transitional housing program.

Rooming House Program

Women's Housing Ltd manages three Rooming Houses in metropolitan Melbourne. Rooming Houses are located at Albion (men only), Mount Martha (mixed gender) and Berwick (mixed gender).

All vacancies for the Rooming House program are advertised on the DHHS Resource Register and all applicants must be registered with the Victorian Housing Register. Women's Housing Ltd will be drawing applicants from the Victorian Housing Register.

Community Housing

Women's Housing Ltd has a range of long term housing options. This housing is targeted at single women and women and children. In order to qualify for this housing, women should be registered with the Victorian Housing Register.

Community Housing is a long term housing option.

All vacancies for the Community Housing Program will be sourced from the Victorian Housing Register. Please refer to the VHR fact sheet for further information about this process.
